THE CITY OF MELILLA

The European enclave that makes up the city of Melilla is integrated into the North African region. Its territory is located in the north-western part of the Maghreb known as Rif. Melilla is bathed by the Mediterranean, on the northern coast of the African continent, opposite the Andalusian coast corresponding to the Alboran Sea.

With a population of approximately 70,000 inhabitants and more than 500 years of history, its location between two continents facing the sea means that several cultures converge here; Berber, Sephardic, Hindu and Christian, which give the city an exoticism unlike any other. Knowing these communities that maintain their identity and fill the streets of the city with a colorful cultural miscegenation, is one of the great attractions that Melilla offers.

Melilla is also characterized becouse of its modernist architecture with more than 900 modernist and art deco buildings, which offers the visitor various nuances to walk through its streets.
